13U AAA & AA (Pee Wee): January 12th through to the 20th

January 11th 5 sessions 4pm to 9pm at Cloverdale Batting Cage, groups to be assigned by the coaching staff.

January 13th 2 sessions 5-6pm, 6-7pm at the Cloverdale Batting Cage

January 14th 2 sessions 7-8pm and 8-9pm at the Cloverdale Batting Cage

January 17th 4 sessions 2-3pm, 3-4pm, 4-5pm and 5-6pm at Apex Football Academy, groups to be assigned by the coaching staff.

AAA Team finalized and AA Sessions to continue, players moving on will be advised by Rangers Program.

To Register for the Tryouts you MUST do the following 2 things

1. Send an email to Dave Palmer at rangersbbdp@gmail.com with the Players Name, your complete home address and which division and level(s) they are trying out for. If out of catchment please email a copy of your tryout release approval from BC Minor.
2. Prior to attending the tryout you MUST be registered with either CMBA for the Spring Baseball Season. The lists will be compared prior to tryouts. If you do not end up playing in Cloverdale the monies will be refunded by CMBA.

Note: Players trying out for 13U AA, 13U AAA, 15U AA, 15U AAA MUST have a tryout release if you do not live within the BC Baseball defined catchment area for Cloverdale Minor Baseball, please follow the instructions below. Please note that Newton Minor Baseball has ceased operations so if you live in the Newton Catchment you are a free agent for the 2026 season and can play for any association and not be considered an import player. Additionally, Newton players do not require a release of any kind for 2026. BC Baseball will be defining new association boundaries for 2027 to encompass the former Newton catchment into Cloverdale/Surrey/Whiterock we would expect.

Rule 6.02 Permission to play in an association outside the boundaries of residence.

Player tryout release must be submitted online (link you need above). Players do not have to notify home association of this as on the BCMBA online form it asks if "your home association offers the program yes/no"...then further down the online form it has this "If Home Association approval answer is yes, a separate email must accompany this application from the Home Association stating so. Sent to eligibility@bcminorbaseball.org Include players name and approval" so this pertains to players trying out elsewhere for program(s) they may also offer (13U AA, 13U AAA, 15U AA & 15U AAA).

18U AAA (also includes CP) does not apply to Rule 6; refer to Rule 7.07 for 18U AAA which same as CP just have to provide player home association 5 days notice in writing to 18U AAA Director and home association.

Side Note: BCMBA has 7-10 days to approve so request should be submitted as soon as possible by player. There usually are well over 100+ of these each year for them to go through.

6.02 Permission to play in an association outside the boundaries of residence.

A candidate who resides within the boundaries of an association and desires to play baseball in another association may do so providing the Association of residence does not provide, either on its own or in combination with another Association, the level of play that the candidate is capable of playing i.e. The Association of residence provides a (A or AA level within a division but the candidate is capable of playing at an AA or AAA level). The player must apply for Preliminary Try-Out Approval by completing the try-out approval form. With approval from the presidents of both their home and tryout Associations. The home association president will confirm if the try-out level is being offered or not and forward the email to the BCMBA Player Eligibility Chair, cc'ing the player/family and the try-out association. BCMBA will have 7-10 days to approve/not approve the application.

The following expedited procedure shall be followed:

- A. The player's residential Association shall declare in writing that it will have no level of play that the candidate is capable of playing in the player's age division for the current season.
- B. Should the player be selected for a AA or AAA team, they shall process an Application for Player Movement to remain at the new Association for the current season only.
- C. All players must first register with their residential Association. Should an Association fail to have sufficient players to form a team in the divisions in question, it may release the players to another Association(s) that will accept them.
- D. No player movement shall take effect until approved by the Player Eligibility Chair. In order for this paragraph to apply, the candidate must make the roster of a team in another Association at the higher level. If the candidate is not successful in making a team roster at the higher level, they will return to the Association of residence.



Cost Breakdowns

General notes that apply to all 6 Rangers HP teams.

- Team fees are determined at the start of the year based on anticipated costs and budgeting for coaching stipends, season/tournament travel & tournament fees etc. Individual team performance and actual in season costs might be less than the amount budgeted.
- To be clear the Team Fees paid to the program for a specific team are **not** subject to end of year refund of any kind.
- Should expenses be less than those budgeted when fees are determined the excess money will be retained by the program to cover future costs and absorbed into the program.
- Note that a separate Team Snap Registration Site will be sent to all selected players following team selection.

13U AA Team

- Rangers AA Team Fee of \$900 payable by E-Transfer to rangers13ufinance@gmail.com
Payment structure is 50% of fee payable upon selection to the team with the balance due by April 15, 2025. Payment by cheque or cash and or a payment plan can be made with approval of the Rangers Management
- Rangers uniform cost, there are items that are mandatory and others that are optional, cost will be determined by any extra items purchased. Approximate cost for Mandatory items is around \$350.
- As this team is **not** a single season team there will be an additional \$200 for the Summer Ball Season payable by E-Transfer to rangers13ufinance@gmail.com This will be due June 1, 2025
 - Therefore, total cost (not including Uniform) is \$1395.00 or \$1445.00

Uniforms

Players Uniform Numbers will be determined by the Rangers program based on the following criteria. Once all teams are selected players will be requested to provide their preferred number followed by 2nd and 3rd choices.

Returning players will retain their current number unless they choose to change numbers when the process below reaches them for selection.

The process starts within each division

- 18U College Prep then AAA
- 15U AAA then AA
- 13UAAA then AA.

Based off seniority in the program and Division. For example a player that has been in the program for multiple years would have selection before a new player in the program.

The same numbers can be issued to players in different divisions but not within the same division.

The reason for this is based off coaches being able to call up players when needed.

Rangers HP Uniform equipment is mandatory for all players in the program, first year players will be required to purchase the following items.

- White Full Button Jersey x 1
- Black Full Button Jersey x 1
- Black drift practice jersey x 1
- ¾ Sleeve practice t-shirt x 1
- PTS 30 hat x 1
- Rangers Hoodie x 1
- Rangers Cage Warm up jacket either short or long sleeve x 1
- Rangers shorts x 1
- Optional 3rd Jersey based on team Request

Returning players can reuse previous year's uniform items provided they are not extremely worn/damaged to help with keeping costs down where possible.

Rangers Player Mandatory Participation Programs

- Participate, as requested, with CMBA player assessments in Feb/March of each year.
- Participate, as requested, in any activities related to Challenger Baseball, typically 1 day of volunteer time.
- Participate, as requested, in any Ranger Program Fund Raising programs, this should be limited to 1 fund raiser per player at the most.
- Participate, as requested, in any workshops/clinics for practices with younger division players for organized development practices, typically 1 day of volunteer time.
